Our classes have been working hard learning capital & lowercase letters. The 3's classes practice writing their names in all capitals, while they continue to recognize their names in title case(1st letter capitalized, rest lower case). Some of our 4's students have made the transition to title case while others continue to practice in all capitals. While the 4's may be using pencils more often now in their writing, it is still beneficial to let them practice writing with small pieces of crayons. The small pieces force the fingers into the correct grip, and the crayons supply a sensory experience that helps the brain to remember the strokes(sensory memory). It's also beneficial to practice letters with a variety of media(eg. markers, chalk, oil pastels, etc). It is important to make writing fun!

#### **Dress for the Weather**

The theme this month is "Weather Fun". The weather changes in February sure have been interesting! It has been nice to venture outdoors and we plan to continue as long as the weather cooperates. Please be sure to encourage your child to dress in clothing that can get dirty(sometimes slightly wet). Also, it is always encouraged to pack hats & gloves in your child's bag just in case.
